**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND NOTICE OF HEARING**

On June 11, 2003, Gregory W. Harris filed a Motion to Approve Re-financing on behalf David and Dawn M. Linn, Case No. 4:00-bk-45462. However, the signature on the Motion was from Brian Wilson. When the attorney who signs a pleading is different than the one who files that pleading, a disparity arises in the docket entry, since the docket only lists the name of the attorney who filed the pleading, not the attorney who signed it. Accordingly, the *Administrative Procedures for Electronically Filed Cases and Related Documents*, as adopted by General Order 19, prohibits this practice. See *Administrative Procedures for Electronically Filed Cases and Related Documents*, ¶ I.C.6. (“When a pleading is filed on the System, the login name must match the signature on attached PDF pleading.”)

Therefore, in response to these matters, Jean Rolfs, Clerk of Court, through a letter dated June 12, 2003, advised Mr. Harris that this practice is prohibited and “[i]f additional pleadings are filed by you on behalf of other attorneys, they will be referred to the Court for further action.” In spite of the June 12, 2003 letter, on August 4, 2003, Mr. Harris electronically filed a petition on behalf of another attorney, Brian Wilson, in the case of Tonya M. Anderson, Case No. 4:03-bk-



19233, and then on August 11, 2003 Mr. Harris filed yet another petition on behalf of Brian Wilson in the case of Avery D. Page, Case No. 4:03-bk-19558. The Avery petition is the **second** petition that Mr. Harris filed on behalf of another attorney **after** Ms. Rolfs sent Mr. Harris the June 12, 2003 letter advising him that this practice is prohibited. Mr. Harris' failure to abide by the procedures of this Court will be the subject of a Show Cause hearing which is set pursuant to this Order.

Accordingly, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that Gregory W. Harris appear and show cause regarding his failure to comply with General Order 19. The Show Cause hearing will be held on September 16, 2003, at 9:30 a.m. at the United States Bankruptcy Courthouse, 300 West Second Street, Room 320, Little Rock, Arkansas.
